## Obituary

While he was there, he served as a union representative, received training in fire and rescue, and got his degree from Jacksonville State University. His last position there was caster maintenance.

He met his bride-to-be at South Eleventh Street Baptist and they married on September 26, 1958. Together they worked hard both in and out of the home to provide for and raise their children. Their lives primarily revolved around their church, family, friends, community, and of course each other. Besides serving in his church, he also served his community as a Councilman for Rainbow City.

He is preceded in death by his wife, Carolyn B. Swindall; his parents, George Troy Swindall and Mattie M. Swindall; eight brothers and sister and their spouses; and a brother and sister who passed in childhood.
